<i>Sparkling</i>	Borgo Col Alto Prosecco Brut Fashionable Italian Sparkler produced in the Veneto region. Delicately fruity, slightly aromatic bouquet with hints of flowers among which honey and wild apple scents are perceived. It is well balanced and light.	VENETO, ITALY
<i>House Champ</i>	Lombard Brut N.V. Straw yellow colour with reflections of gold. The nose is fresh with touches of vanilla and there is an abundance of fine persistent bubbles. The palate is rounded with toasty overtones.	CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
<i>Premium House Champagne</i>	Philipponnat Royale Reserve Fresh and vinous, Royale Reserve epitomises the Philipponnat style, marked by the terroirs of Ay and Mareuil-sur-Ay and by its Pinot Noir grapes from premier and grand cru vineyards, which confer wonderful vinosity and body. After three years of maturing on the lees, Royale Reserve acquires a delightful degree of maturity but remains refreshing, thus making it an excellent aperitif wine. A fantastic champagne! <i>Grand Marque Champagne</i>	Laurent Perrier Brut N.V. Pale gold in colour with a delicate and complex nose, with hints of citrus and white fruits. Fresh and easy on the palate, with full flavours, plenty of fruit, good balance and length	CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
<i>Grand Marque Champagne</i>	Louis Roederer Brut Premier N.V Pale golden in colour with a rich yet subtle bouquet, with hints of hawthorn, almonds and toast. Brut Premier is the embodiment of the house style and strikes a perfect balance between the structure and fruitiness of Pinot Noir and the finesse of the Chardonnay. Smooth and complex with lovely notes of toast and almonds and a fantastic rich and dry finish. One of the great family houses in Champagne!	CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
<i>Grand Marque Champagne</i>	Perrier Jouët Grand Brut N.V. Lovely aromas and flavours of tropical fruit, citrus, spice and yeast dominate this elegant, complex, crisp and balanced Champagne. A fine, persistent mousse is followed by lingering flavours of fresh apples and lemons.	CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
<i>Grand Marque Champagne</i>	Perrier Jouët Blason Rosé N.V. Beautifully crafted and produced in limited volumes at their famous cellars in Epernay. Salmon pink with coppery highlights, with elegant aromas of red fruits and rose petals. This aromatic richness is followed by a full flavoured wine, hints of raspberry, strawberry and citrus flavours.	CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

<i>Grand Marque Champagne</i>	<p>Laurent Perrier Brut Rosé N.V.</p> <p>One of the few rosé Champagnes made by a technique called 'saignee', where the red grape skins are left on the wine for up to 3 days, giving the wine its unique deep salmon pink colour. On the nose the wine shows hints of red and black fruit, reminiscent of raspberries, black cherries and blackcurrants. The wine is fresh, rounded and supple, with a long finish.</p>	CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
<i>Prestige Cuvée Champagne</i>	<p>Perrier Jouët Belle Epoque</p> <p>This is Perrier Jouët's Prestige Cuvée and one of the finest champagnes presented by a grand marque. It is frequently praised for its consistency and complexity. It evolves in the mouth displaying all the facets of its laborious years of ageing in the cellars. On the nose it has creamy, rich aromas and on the palate it is fresh delicate and refined. Above all it displays finesse and quality, the two characteristics Perrier Jouët is so good at.</p>	CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
<i>Prestige Cuvée Champagne</i>	<p>Krug Vintage</p> <p>A rich, elegant, bright gold colour with strong multiple aromas. In the mouth it is ample, tender and silky, intense and rich. An aroma of dried, exotic fruits with a scent of figs on the nose and sultry excitement on the palate</p>	CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
<i>House White</i>	<p>Duc du Chapelle Sauvignon Blanc</p> <p>Aromatic Sauvignon, typically grassy with zesty lemon and lime character and lively fresh acidity. Exotic gooseberry and grapefruit flavours develop on a well balanced palate ending with fresh rounded acidity.</p>	V.D.P., FRANCE
<i>House White</i>	<p>La Playa Unoaked Chardonnay</p> <p>A modern unoaked dry wine from vines grown in the foothills of the Andes mountains. Fresh with tropical fruit flavours and a good dollop of citrus acidity in the finish.</p>	COLCHAGUA, CHILE
<i>House White</i>	<p>Boira Organic Pinot Grigio</p> <p>This well-balanced Pinot Grigio is made from low yielding organic vineyards, which contribute intensity and ripeness. It has floral aromas of acacia and honeysuckle, white peach flavours and a fresh lemony finish.</p>	VENETO, ITALY
<i>White</i>	<p>La Playa Viognier</p> <p>Rose petal perfumed and fragrant this grape produces fashionable easy drinking whites and this excellent example has a delightful aroma and flavours of dried fruits and lychee in the finish.</p>	COLCHAGUA, CHILE
<i>White</i>	<p>Backsberg Chenin Blanc</p> <p>Sourced from the Western Cape, this fantastic example has ripe fruit, tempered by finely balanced acidity to give a mouth filling, yet refreshing palate, which has a lingering finish.</p>	WESTERN CAPE, S.A.
<i>White</i>	<p>Pisano 'Rio Pajaros' Torrontés</p> <p>This is simply delicious! A bouquet of wild roses and pear-drop fruits and an unexpected crispness make this one of South America's best versions of Torrontes. Fragrant and pure with a clean fruitiness to the finish.</p>	PROGESO, URUGUAY

<i>White</i>	Icely Rd Riesling High altitude, cool climate trendy Aussie white. Attractively aromatic on the palate, with a delicate mix of lemon, lime and orange blossom. On the palate honeyed lime flavours are supported by mineral notes, followed by a fine, long finish.	ORANGE, AUSTRALIA
<i>White</i>	Condes de Albarei Albariño The Albariño grape variety thrives on its cool coastal location making this wine fresh and elegant with a captivating floral bouquet and peach flavours. It is believed that Albariño is a distant relative to the Riesling grape.	GALICIA, SPAIN
<i>White</i>	Peter Dolle 'Gaisberg' Grüner Veltliner Grüner Veltliner is by far Austria's most important grape variety. It's immensely fresh aromas of herbs and peach blossom are permeated with fine mineral and peppery undertones are the hallmarks of this wine along with a finish of vibrant acidity.	KAMPTAL, AUSTRIA
<i>White</i>	Astrolabe Sauvignon Blanc Picked in the cool evening to retain acidity and freshness, it is pale straw in colour with green highlights. A fresh aroma of lemon grass and lime peel precedes a panopoly of citrus fruit flavours. Air New Zealand Gold medal winner 3 years running and IWSC trophy winner for best Sauvignon Blanc	MARLBOROUGH, N.Z.
<i>White</i>	Terre da Vino 'Ca da Bosio' Gavi di Gavi Perfumed mineral character adding complexity to lively aromas of ripe fruit and flowers. 'Ca da Bosio' is further refined by extended lees contact which imparts eloquent, complex, lingering hints of vanilla to the soft-textured dry finish.	PIEDMONT, ITALY
<i>White</i>	Hamelin Bay '5 Ashes Vineyard' Chardonnay Winemaker Julian Scott at Hamelin Bay since early 2000, has achieved another level of class and consistency taking advantage of this cool climate region to produce an elegant wine with integrated oak and a butterscotch finish. <i>White</i>	Sancerre, Domaine Crochet Classic Sauvignon Blanc from the Central Vineyards of the Loire Valley. Lovely grassy aroma and well balanced ripe flavours, with excellent balance and full sweet fruit on the palate.	LOIRE, FRANCE
<i>White</i>	Chablis 1er Cru 'Fourchaume' Domaine N & G Fevre This premier cru Chablis originates from vineyards situated on long slopes facing the sunrise, allowing the sun to warm the soil for as long as possible. Long and rich, with fruity flavours and mineral notes and a lovely smooth rounded finish.	BURGUNDY, FRANCE
<i>House Rosé</i>	Il Paradosso Nero d'Avola Rosato An alluring Sicilian rosé made from the island's bold and flavourful local hero, Nero d'Avola, with the addition of a little Frappato, a local white variety that contributes to the wine's elegance. It is an attractive light strawberry pink rosé with a fruit scented bouquet and notes of summer fruits. This easy drinking dry rosé is soft, crisp, well-balanced on the palate; rounded by a fresh acidity and a hint of mineral.	SICILY, ITALY

<i>Rosé</i>	Domaine du Grand Mayne Cab Merlot Rosé A delicate salmon pink rosé made by the `saignée` method of bleeding the fermenting juice from the skins, to preserve the fruit flavours and aroma. It is a dry with a perfumed bouquet of summer fruits, vibrant fruit on the palate and crisp acidity.	V.D.P. DURAS, FRANCE
<i>Rosé</i>	Laibach Pinotage Rosé On the nose a lovely array of strawberry, mulberry and hints of cherry entice before exploding in the mouth with concentrated red berry characters. Beautifully balanced with a lively acidity to make this wine fresh and taste even fresher.	STELLENBOSCH, S.A.
<i>Rosé</i>	Domaine d'Olivette Bandol Rosé The pretty fishing village of Bandol, south of Marseille, makes fragrant dry rosé wine regarded as the best of Provence. The delicate salmon pink is achieved by the saignée method of `bleeding` the fermenting juice of Grenache, Cinsault and Mourvèdre.	PROVENCE, FRANCE
<i>Rosé</i>	André Neveu Sancerre Rosé This single vineyard Sancerre rosé has the added complexity of mineral flavours on the mid weight, creamy textured palate. A pale salmon pink rosé, fresh with a delicate perfumed bouquet, finishing dry, well rounded with exceptional poise.	LOIRE, FRANCE
<i>House Red</i>	Duc du Chapelle Cabernet Merlot An easy drinking blend of Cabernet Sauvignon for body, backbone and blackcurranty flavours, with the Merlot adding soft plummy notes.	V.D.P., FRANCE
<i>House Red</i>	La Playa Cabernet Sauvignon This classic French grape variety flourishes in Chile's clean maritime climate in the foothills of the Andes mountains. Expressive blackberry and cherry notes balanced with a soft creamy palate.	COLCHAGUA, CHILE
<i>House Red</i>	Boira Organic Sangiovese Rich ruby colour, the aroma is laden with stone fruit and brambles. The palate is smooth and balanced with plum overtones. Silky tannins give firm structure with a lengthy finish on the palate.	MARCHES, ITALY
<i>Red</i>	Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, San Antonio Deep purple in colour with intense aromas and rich, robust characteristics typical of the l'Aquila province of Abruzzo. Intensely spicy with cherryish flavours and well rounded. A portion was aged in oak to soften the palate and add some smokey character.	ABRUZZI, ITALY
<i>Red</i>	Tres Palacios 'Reserve' Camenère Chile's signature red grape varietal is treated with a stylish makeover here. Deep purple colour with shade with some violet hues. The nose is ripe with a nice perfume that includes spice and minerality.	MAIPO, CHILE

<i>Red</i>	<p>Valle Perdido Malbec</p> <p>Deep violet in colour with vibrant and expressive aromas of red fruit and orange peel. Full bodied and juicy, with elegant tannins and mineral notes.</p>	PATAGONIA, ARGENTINA
<i>Red</i>	<p>l'Amandine Côtes du Rhône</p> <p>The spice and smoky aromas of the Syrah dominate the bouquet, whilst red fruits and spice compete on the palate.</p>	SOUTHERN RHÔNE, FRANCE
<i>Red</i>	<p>Château le Gardera Bordeaux Superieur</p> <p>This fantastic property is among the best of the appellation, producing firm, rich wine from 60% Merlot and 40% Cabernet Sauvignon. Le Gardera has fine tannins, soft fruit with subtle oak and an excellent balance.</p>	BORDEAUX, FRANCE
<i>Red</i>	<p>Azabache Organic Rioja Crainza</p> <p>Tasty and complex in the mouth with good structure with integrated fruit and wood, followed by a long lasting aftertaste with pleasant dominance of mature fruit.</p>	RIOJA, SPAIN
<i>Red</i>	<p>Laibach Merlot</p> <p>Hand selected grapes and natural free run juice, produces a rich and complex aroma. Clearly defined notes of violets and seductive plumminess lead through to silky ripe tannins which are supported with spicy notes. This is a sensational award winning wine.</p>	STELLENBOSCH, S.A.
<i>Red</i>	<p>Parri Estate 'Pangkarra' Grenache</p> <p>Hand-picked from 70 year old bush vines, this wine has a great colour which is typical of this varietal. Black cherries and clove aromas dominate preceding mocha and black fruit flavours. Hints of spice and vanilla, derived from a years maturation in small French barrels add complexity and richness to a long finish.</p>	MCLAREN VALE, AUST
<i>Red</i>	<p>Geoff Merrill 'Premium' Shiraz</p> <p>From undoubtedly Australia's King of Shiraz, this wine is dark and youthful in colour. The nose shows subtle toasty oak, moving to fruit aromas of spice and fresh berries. Rich, well structured on the palate, a savoury integrated oak adds complexity to this fantastic red finishing with long, lingering fruitiness.</p>	MCLAREN VALE, AUST
<i>Red</i>	<p>Georges Blanc Fleurie 'la Madone'</p> <p>Fleurie has a distinctly floral bouquet of violets and summer fruits and is perhaps the most approachable and elegant of the Beaujolais Crus. A fruity wine exhibiting an aroma of wild strawberries and lush ripe flavours.</p>	BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE
<i>Red</i>	<p>Astrolabe Pinot Noir</p> <p>Acclaimed winemaker Simon Waghorn scores again with this medium bodied rich fruited red wine. By far, New Zealand's premier red grape variety, it is refined and smokey, with a long elegant finish. Classy, top notch Pinot with integrated smooth silky tannins that will rival any good Burgundy!</p>	MARLBOROUGH
<i>Red</i>	<p>Château Haut Badon Grand Cru Saint-Emilion</p> <p>A perfect blend producing a soft rich and blackcurranty red with complex, elegant flavours derived from oak barrel maturation. A pleasant nose with aromas of red berries. A smooth, delicate and balanced wine, deep and bright in colour.</p>	BORDEAUX, FRANCE
